Tax Considerations

Under the Internal Revenue Code, health care professionals are allowed to deduct educational expenses including tuition fees, meals, travel and lodging as long as they meet certain specific criteria. These criteria deal with the length of the trip and the percent of total travel time devoted to business and non-business activities. However each person's individual situation must be evaluated by their tax advisor to determine whether they meet the requirements of deductibility for all or any portion of their travel expenses. You must contact your tax advisor to evaluate your situation.

You'll receive a \$150 tuition fee discount when you take a 2nd program in a different city during the same trip (i.e. London and Paris, etc.)

How The International CME Programs Work

Each program consists of self-directed, individual learning activities that offer you flexibility and convenience. You select your learning objectives (see program design), choose the amount of time (not available on weekends and holidays) you will spend, and select the learning activities that help you to meet your objectives.

You will be given access to an English-speaking host physician with whom you will meet and have one-on-one discussions. Your host physician will help you meet your learning objectives through visits to other hospitals, clinics and health care facilities (subject to availability).

You can participate in up to 24 hours of self-directed learning activities in any of the cities listed above. After fulfilling your self-directed learning activities and upon your written verification, you will be sent a course certificate for your records.

Program Tuition Fees

The tuition fee for the CME program in any of the cities listed above is \$395. For a spouse wishing to formally register for the program, the tuition fee is only \$245. The tuition fee for a second program in a different city is \$245 per person.

Program Design

The information gained can be beneficial in becoming an active participant in health care reform in the USA and providing quality cost effective patient care. *Speciality and clinical studies are not part of the program.*

Sample Individual CME Programs

London*

Discussions on the British National Health Service with your host physician; visits to Guys , St. Thomas or any one of London's famous hospitals for tour and discussions on hospital based medicine and discussions on the role of the G.P. in the health care delivery scheme; attend lectures at the Royal Society of Medicine.

Paris*

Discussions on the French health care delivery system with your host physician; visit the Pasteur Institute, Department of Infectious Disease for an update on AIDS, tour Louis Pasteur's Library and Museum; visit Hospitals Madame Curie and Charcot.

Jerusalem*

Discussions on the Israeli health care delivery system with your host physician; visit the Hadassa medical complex in Jerusalem at Ein Karem and Mt. Scopus; visit the cancer center at the Weitsman Institute.

Rome*

Discussions on the Italian health care delivery system with your host physician; visit the Catholic University Hospital of Rome; visit Hospital Sansepocro with discussions on the role of the government in providing maternal and infant care.

* These programs are examples only. Since each individual's program is self-directed, the topics, faculty, and visits will be different than listed above. Availability of faculty and facilities depends on the dates and times selected. Activities are not available on weekends or local and national holidays.
